A clause is a group of words that contains a subject and a verb.

INDEPENDENT CLAUSE- Can be a complete sentence

↳ **Example:** *She went to the store.*



DEPENDENT CLAUSE-

can be part of a sentence

↳ **Example:**

Because I was tired

PHRASES-

A phrase is a group of words that does not have a subject and a verb. They work together as a team within a sentence.



INFINITIVE PHRASE-

A phrase that includes an infinitive verb, which is usually "to" following by the base form of a verb

→ **Example:**

***To swim** in the ocean is my dream.*



POSITIVE PHRASE

a group of words that identifies or renames a noun or pronoun in a sentence.

Example:

*My friend, **the talented artist**, won the art competition.*



GERUND PHRASE-

A phrase that includes a gerund, which is a verb form that is used as a noun

Example: *I enjoy **reading books** in my free time.*



PARTICIPLE PHRASE-

a group of words that includes a participle (verb form) and acts as an adjective, modifying a noun or pronoun.

↳ **Example:**

*The dog, **excited to go for a walk**, barked happily.*



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↳ **Example:**

The dog, excited to go for a walk, barked happily.

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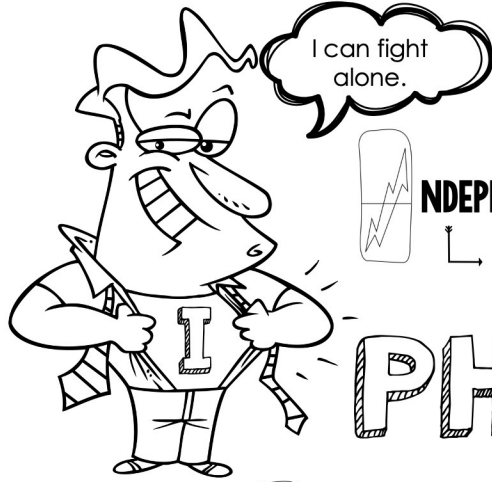
