

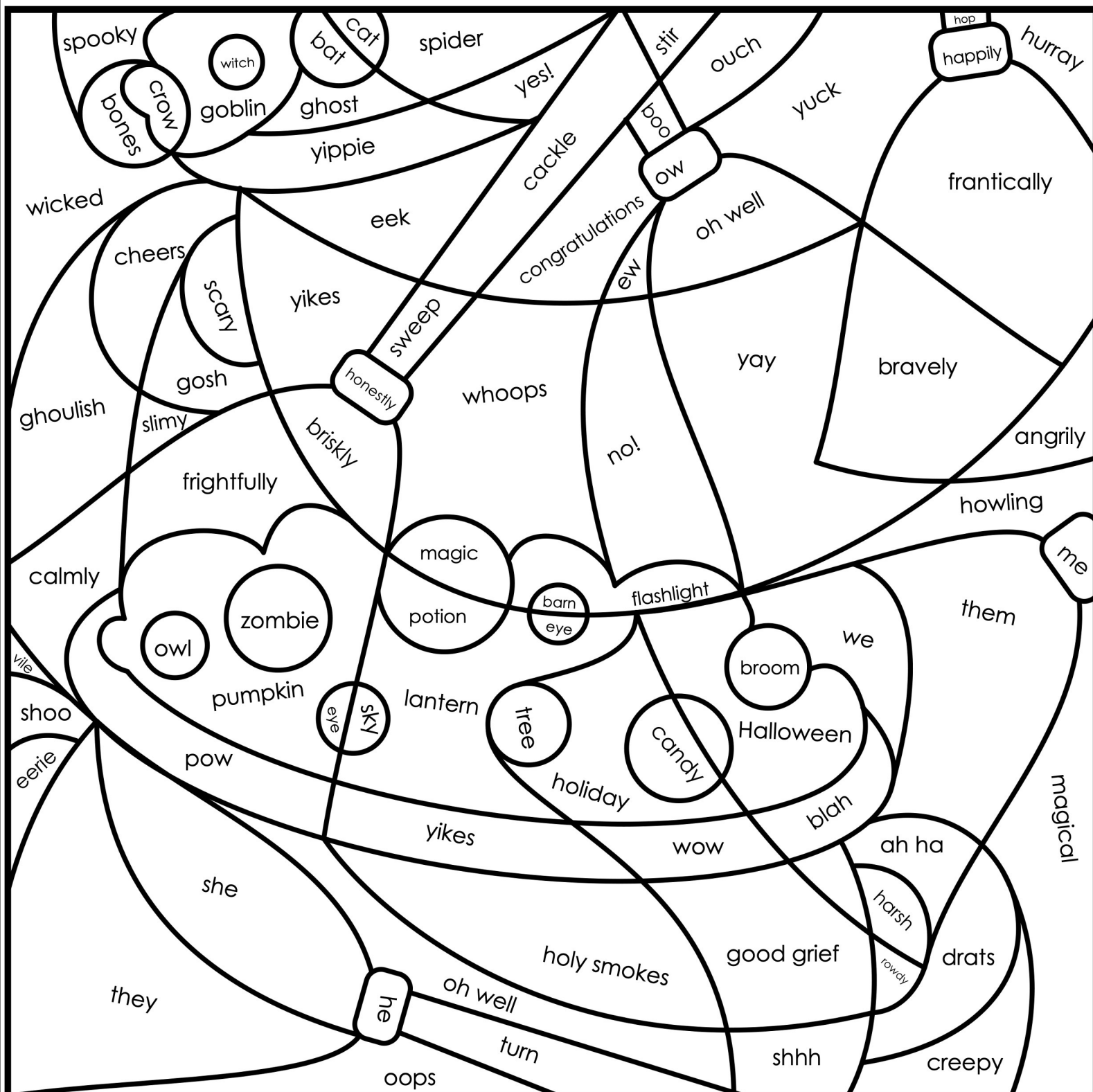
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Color each space based on the key below.

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PARTS OF SPEECH

noun: a word that names a person, place, thing, or idea.

adjective: a word that describes or modifies nouns and pronouns.

interjection: a word that conveys emotion or surprise.

verb: a word that indicates action or state of being.

adverb: a word that modifies a verb, adjective, phrase, or clause by indicating how, where, when, or how much.

conjunction: a word that links other words, phrases, or clauses together.

pronoun: a word that replaces a noun without specifying a name.



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
